


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

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HOW TO RECOGNISE DANGEROUS NOISE



There are three different ways to know if the noise is loud enough to be dangerous.

Also, if you hear ringing or buzzing sounds inside your ears after the shift, the noise was too loud.

Wherever the noise is dangerous you should be wearing your HPDs.

First of all, wherever you see this blue and white warning sign, the noise is dangerous.



Another way to know if the noise is dangerous is when people must shout to hear each other.






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DIFFERENT TYPES OF HPDs

humid areas.










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




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

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
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FITTING UNMOULDED EARPLUGS




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YOUR CHOICE OF HPDs DEPENDS ON WHERE YOU WORK




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FOR EARPLUGS TO PROTECT YOU, THEY MUST FIT PROPERLY



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SAFETY RULES FOR EARPLUGS



To avoid discomfort caused by differences in air presure, slightly loosen your ear plugs before opening ventilation doors or travelling in the cage.

DO NOT wear your earplugs if you get an infection or a sore inside your ears.
Have the problem seen to at the Medical Station.
